

# Crosby Quilt Guild “Treasures from the Heart”

## **Mini Quilt Show and Auction Rules** **September 11, 2006**

### **Eligibility to Participate**

All entrants must be a Crosby Quilt Guild member. Non-members who wish to participate are welcome to join the guild, pay their dues, and enter quilts in the show. All quilts are due at the guild meeting on ?????.

### **Quilt Specifications**

The quilt can be no larger than 44” x 64”.

All quilts must be finished, quilted and bound. Quilts with any side greater than 12 inches must have at least a two-inch hanging sleeve on the top back of the quilt.

All quilts must be submitted with an entry form.

All quilts will be judged.

All quilts must have a label on the back of the quilt with the name of the quilt, maker of the quilt, quilter’s name if not done by the maker, and year completed.

Everyone who worked on the project must be listed on the label.

Credit must be given for any non-original pattern used.

Fusibles must have the edges secured with stitching.

Previous entries to the show cannot be entered to be judged again. They can be included in a “special” display, however.

Non-traditional bindings can be used without penalty.

**Description of Categories:** (Quilts may be entered into only one of the following categories. Appliqué, pieced and mixed techniques will be divided into two categories each: 1 person and or 2 or more persons. Merit quilting will be divided into two categories: hand and machine.)

Appliqué	Quilts constructed using at least 50% appliqué.
Pieced	Quilts constructed using only piecing. Paper-piecing would be in this category.
Mixed Techniques	Quilts using more than one technique; ie. pieced and appliqué
Merit Quilting	Quilts entered primarily on the quality of the quilting stitches and quilting pattern and quilted by machine or hand. Whole cloths should be entered in this category unless qualified for miniature category.
Miniature	Quilts with overall patterns reflecting reduced scale and miniaturization. If blocks are used, they should be no larger than 4-inches square. <i>Quilts must measure less than 24-inches on each side.</i>
Machine Embroidery And “Cheater-Cloth” Creations	Embroidered quilts made using designs created for computerized systems and using original digitized designs and/or embroidery design cards or discs. Computer embroidery design software may also be used. Cheater Cloth (quilt design is the design on the fabric) quilts are part of this category. Quantity and importance of quilting will be a consideration in this category.
